Lady Cavs bound for Indy

Coming off a 60-43 win over Southern Wells, Canterbury heads south on I-69 riding a 13-game winning streak to the state finals at Conesco Fieldhouse. The Lady Cavs will take on University High School on Saturday for the chance to claim Class A superiority for 2007-08.

It will be the first state finals appearance for a Canterbury girls team in any sport. Canterbury has only won a team state championship in boys soccer.

Canterbury enters the state championship game with a record of 20-5. Tabitha Gerardot and Cassie Kreiger combined for 41 points to lead the Lady Cavaliers to a 60-43 win over Southern Wells on February 23 at the Plymouth Semistate.

Canterbury knocked off both Class A #1 Oregon-Davis and #2 Kouts to win the Caston Regional on February 16.

Quick Notes

- Canterbury and University have faced off twice since 2000, both times in Carmel. Canterbury won both meetings, the most recent a 62-50 game on Jan. 26, 2007.
- Canterbury is 9-0 in games against Class A opponents in 2007-08, and is 48-5 against Class A over the past 5 seasons.

Kreiger leads Lady Cavs to state finals

Sophomore forward Cassie Kreiger scored 19 points and shot 70% from the floor to lead Canterbury to a 60-43 win over Southern Wells in the Plymouth semistate.

Becky Pedro came out firing, as she made the first two baskets of the game to give Canterbury a quick 4-0 lead. Despite those baskets, and 8 first-quarter points from Kreiger, Canterbury trailed 20-19 at halftime. Improved defensive intensity after the break helped the Lady Cavs run away from the Lady Raiders, and Aubrey Holle's strong free-throw shooting down the stretch sealed the first trip to the state finals for any Canterbury girls team. Tabitha Gerardot had a big second half for Canterbury and finished as the game's leading scorer with 22 points.

Canterbury knocks off #1 and #2, advances to semistate

The Canterbury Lady Cavaliers pushed their winning streak to 12 games by knocking off the state's top 2 teams in Class A on February 16 to win the Caston Regional.

Senior point guard Aubrey Holle made 7 of her 8 free throws in the final 1:30 to ice a 49-43 victory over #1 and previously undefeated Oregon-Davis in the morning game. The Lady Cavs rallied from a 9-point deficit at the start of the fourth quarter and outscored the Lady Bobcats 27-12 in the final stanza to pick up the victory. Freshman Becky Pedro and sophomore Paige Wells locked down defensively on Oregon-Davis stars Aubrey (15 points) and Gabrielle (6 points) Minix. Canterbury stopped a 43-game win streak for Oregon-Davis, which had beaten the Lady Cavaliers 72-69 in the final of the Culver Regional in 2007.

Sophomore forwards Tabitha Gerardot and Cassie Kreiger came up big for Canterbury in the nightcap, as they combined for 33 points in a 46-44 victory over #2 Kouts in the regional final. Kreiger was forced to become a ball handler and go-to player down the stretch when Aubrey Holle went down with a gash on her head with 1:34 to play. Holle was taken to the hospital for stitches. Becky Pedro blocked a layup with less than two seconds remaining to preserve the victory for the Lady Cavs.

Lady Cavs claim 5th straight sectional title

Canterbury's status as the best team in the Elkhart Christian sectional was rarely in doubt, as the Lady Cavs won their two games by a combined total of 68 points on their way to the 8th sectional victory in the past 9 seasons for head coach Scott Kreiger.

In the first-round win over Hamilton, Tabitha Gerardot poured in 25 points and grabbed 14 rebounds before leaving the game, along with the rest of the Lady Cavs' starters, with 2:00 left in the third quarter. Becky Pedro added 10 points and 4 assists for Canterbury in the 72-35 blowout.

Led by senior point guard Aubrey Holle, Canterbury's pressing defense grabbed 19 steals and didn't look back en route to a 58-27 victory over Bethany Christian in the sectional final. Holle had 9 of Canterbury's thefts, to go along with 6 assists and 16 points. Tabitha Gerardot notched her 11th consecutive double-double with 18 points and 11 rebounds on the night.

Game Notes

Canterbury-University basketball history

Canterbury and University have faced off in girls basketball twice since 2000. The first meeting, on January 8, 2005, was a 55-24 Canterbury victory in Carmel. Freshman guard Aubrey Holle scored 19 points on 7-10 shooting and dished out 5 assists for the Lady Cavs.

The second game was played last season, January 26, 2007, again at Carmel. Canterbury came away with a 62-50 win. Tabitha Gerardot, then a freshman, scored 13 points and pulled down 9 rebounds for Canterbury. Current Lady Cavaliers Aubrey Holle, Cassie Kreiger, Molly Kulow and Paige Wells also played in that game. See page 4 for complete statistics.

First appearance at state finals

The Canterbury Lady Cavaliers are making their first appearance in the Indiana girls basketball state finals. This will be the first appearance in the state finals for a Canterbury girls team in any sport.

Postseason success not new for Lady Cavs

Since head coach Scott Kreiger took over 10 years ago, Canterbury has won 8 sectional titles, including each of the last five seasons. The victory at the Caston Regional was Canterbury's second regional win, adding to the 2004 Culver regional championship. Kreiger's father, Wayne, is the head girls coach at Columbia City; he led the Eagles to the 2000 Class 3A state championship game against Cathedral.

Canterbury faces top-notch schedule

The Lady Cavaliers have played an extremely challenging schedule in 2007-08. Of their 5 losses, four have come against teams that advanced to the regional final in their class. Two Canterbury opponents, Carmel and Indianapolis Bishop Chatard, are state finals participants, while Fort Wayne South Side lost in the semistate round to South Bend Washington.

Holle adds to all-time records

Aubrey Holle has added to her school career records for assists and steals all season. She has more than 300 of each during her career at Canterbury.

Holle tops 1,000 career points

Lady Cavalier senior point guard Aubrey Holle topped 1,000 points in her Canterbury career when she sank a free throw in the second quarter on January 24 against Fremont. Fittingly, Holle's big night came on Senior Night, her last home game as a lady Cavalier.

Gerardot averages double-double

Sophomore forward Tabitha Gerardot averages more than 18 points and 10 rebounds per game in 2007-08. Gerardot scored in double figures in every contest this season for the Lady Cavaliers, and had at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in 17 of her 25 appearances for Canterbury. At one point, Gerardot recorded a double-double in 11 consecutive games.

Family history of state success

Freshman guard Becky Pedro comes from a family that has experience at the girls basketball state finals. Her older sister Amanda is a senior at Fort Wayne Bishop Luers, where she was a starter on the 2005-06 Class 3A state champion Knights; she has committed to play basketball at Indiana State. Pedro's sister Megan, now a junior at Canterbury, was a reserve on the 05-06 Bishop Luers team. She did not participate in athletics this year as a result of IHSAA transfer rules.

On the heels of an all-time leader

Most members of the 2007-08 Lady Cavaliers played at least one season with Megan King, Canterbury Class of 2007. King finished her career as the third leading scorer in the history of Indiana high school girls basketball, and the fifth leading scorer among all boys and girls who have ever played in the state, with 2,652 points.

School has history of state appearances

The Canterbury boys varsity soccer team has advanced to the state Final Four in Indianapolis eight times since 1993. Coach Greg Mauch has led the Cavaliers to three state titles, in 1997, 1998 and 2001.
